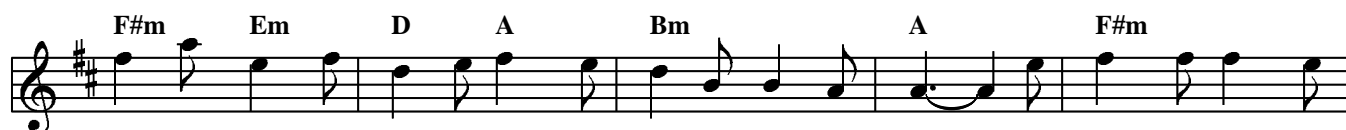


Scots Wha' Ha'e

Traditional/Burns



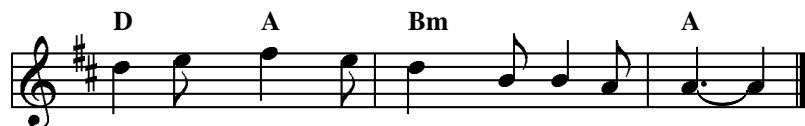
Scots, wha hae wi' Wal-lace bled, Scots, wham Bruce has af-ten led,
